CCSC is comprised of three choir levels and welcomes young people from first grade through high school. Known for their dedication, teamwork, and artistic excellence, the children pursue an ambitious schedule. In addition to local concerts, they have performed at venues including Carnegie Hall, The White House, Prague's Smetana Hall, the Candelaria Church in Rio de Janeiro, and the Vatican. They performed for the July 4th Celebration at the American Embassy in Brussels, the American Cemetery at Omaha Beach and other amazing venues throughout the region. 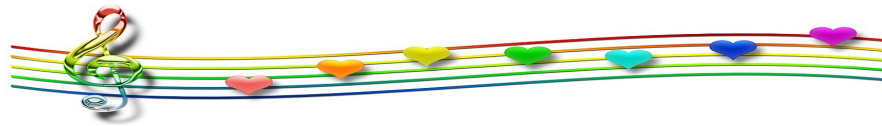
